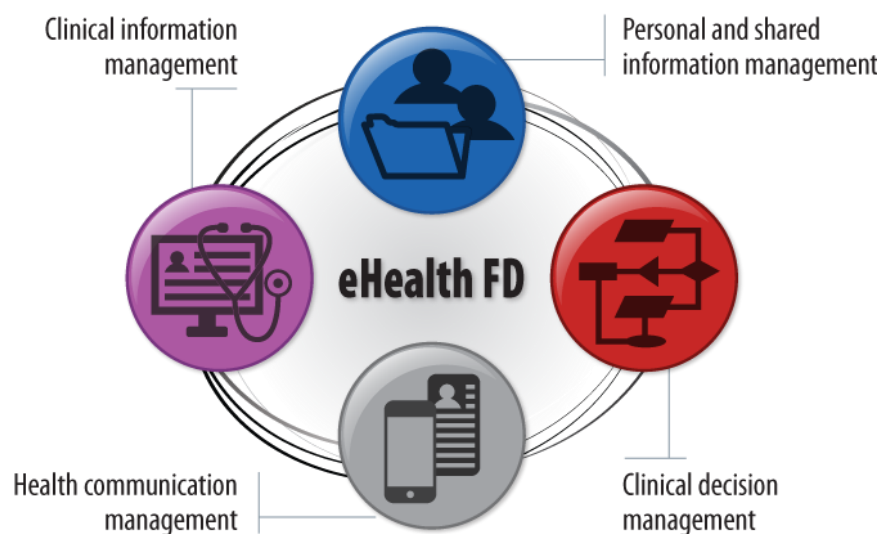


## AFMC – Infoway

### eHealth Faculty Development Series – eHealth FD

Technological innovations are rapidly changing medical practice and patient expectations. This and the inevitability of eHealth integration into accreditation standards and competencies are major drivers for eHealth / health informatics integration into medical curricula and continuing professional development. In support, the Association of Faculties of Medicine of Canada in partnership with Canada Health Infoway will be running a series of national eHealth faculty development (FD) workshops targeted to medical educators and residents who teach medical students. There are four workshops covering a range of topics, including digital professionalism, electronic medical records, medical error and eSafety, telemedicine, patient-focused digital health solutions, and in each session thought will be given to how these topics might be integrated into undergraduate curriculum.



Each workshop will be conducted several times through live webinar from January to March 2016 by an eHealth expert from a Canadian medical school. In addition to the workshops there will be an eHealth FD Toolkit with learning tools, podcasts of key teachings abstracted from the FD workshops and study guides. Accreditation for the workshop series and podcasts is being pursued.
